A Short History of Southern Illinois. The Early Years. Southern Illinois is bordered on three sides by the Mississippi, Ohio, and Wabash rivers. Several other rivers traverse its countryside, including the Big and Little Muddy, Little Wabash, Saline, and Cache rivers. The southern part of the state is characterized by wooded hills, farms, underground coal mines, strip mines, and low marsh lands.

Southern Illinois clay supplied the raw materials for brick manufacturers, used to construct buildings as the wood supply dwindled. By the 1870s, Illinois was exporting large quantities of bricks. Bricks made in Murphysboro were used in the construction of the Panama Canal. Fluorspar, a beautiful crystallized mineral used in the making of glass and steel in the early days and in fiberglass and welding rods later, was mined in Southern Illinois in Hardin County since before the Civil War.
