Incidence of *E. chaffeensis* ehrlichiosis generally increases with age, however, case-fatality rates are highest among children aged <10 years and adults aged  $\geq 70$  years.

Ehrlichiosis is a disease caused by the bacteria *Ehrlichia chaffeensis* which infects white blood cells (monocytes). *Ehrlichia* was previously known as human monocytic ehrlichiosis (HME).
