Hospice is covered by Medicare, Medicaid, and most private insurance. Hospice is available to individuals with end-stage illness for which there is no cure. But hospice care is not limited to the last few days of a patient's life. In fact, hospice is designed to provide support throughout the final stages of illness.

You pay nothing for Hospice care. You may need to pay a Copayment of no more than \$5 for each prescription drug and other similar products for pain relief and symptom control while you're at home. In the rare case your drug isn't covered by the hospice benefit, your hospice provider should contact your Medicare drug plan to see if it's covered under Part D.

Hospice Care - Your Questions Answered

Families of people who received care through a hospice program are more satisfied with end-of-life care than are those of people who did not have hospice services. Also, hospice recipients are more likely to have their pain controlled and less

likely to undergo tests or be given medicines they don't need, compared with people who don't use hospice care.
