Hustler Magazine, Inc. v. Falwell, 485 U.S. 46 (1988), was a landmark decision of the US Supreme Court ruling that the First and Fourteenth Amendments prohibit public figures from recovering damages for the tort of intentional infliction of emotional distress (IIED), if the emotional distress was caused by a caricature, parody, or satire of the public figure that a reasonable person would not have interpreted as factual.
