The primary goal in the management of syndesmotic injuries is to achieve stable, anatomic alignment of the ankle joint, regardless of patient age, or method of management. 32 Most agree that ligamentous syndesmotic injuries, which retain the normal bony relationship of the distal TF joint, can be managed without surgery. Nonoperative treatment of syndesmosis injuries often begins with some form of ankle immobilization for 3 to 6 weeks to allow the ligaments to heal.
