Bing: Teaching Poetry In High School

Listen for rhythm as you read the poem aloud. Pause where punctuation marks appear, not where the line ends. Stopping at appropriate spots helps clarify meaning. Pay attention to sound devices. Skilled poets use sound devices for a reason, usually to draw attention to major points. Read the poem aloud several times.
